

Join Us on a Hike for National Trails Day!



On June 11, 2005, come out to Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park to have some family fun! National Trails Day encourages Americans to get out and enjoy the trails of local, state and federal parks. You'll have a chance to learn some history and get a great workout!

The guided historical hikes offered are as follows:
9:15 a.m. – 6 mile loop over Kennesaw
Mountain, Little Kennesaw and Pigeon Hill
10:00 a.m. – 1 mile from Kennesaw Mountain to Visitor
Center (hikers are shuttled to mountaintop)
1:00 p.m. – 1 mile from Kennesaw Mountain to Visitor
Center (hikers are shuttled to mountaintop)
2:00 p.m. – 2 mile loop to top of Kennesaw
Mountain and back
Be sure to wear proper footwear for hiking on dirt trails and have plenty of water.

All hikes are free. Please call 770-427-4686 x0 between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. or come into the Visitor Center to register for the hike of your choice.
