

Invasive Plants Report – FFY ending 9/30/18

FFY18 was another successfully year of controlling invasive plants!

We were able to do the following:

- Have a group control invasives most of the monthly work days and several other days throughout the month
- Lead several HS groups during the fall and winter controlling large amounts of privet
- Worked with the NPS Exotic Plant Management Team out of SC to control wisteria, privet, and tree-of-heaven
- Work 3 days with the SCA to control privet along the assault trail creek watershed
- Survey and find either new populations or previously unknown existing populations of kudzu, tree of heaven, privet, and tallow tree.
- Work with an adjacent landowner to control invasives on their property to limit the introduction of new exotic plants in the park
