

150 years ago in the Civil War

- Apr 4 Federal ironclad gunboat runs the batteries at Island No. 10 on the Mississippi River
- Apr 5 Siege of Yorktown, Virginia begins
- Apr 6 Battle of Shiloh (Pittsburg Landing), Tennessee begins
- Apr 10 Lincoln approves resolution calling for gradual emancipation of slaves
- Apr 11 Surrender of Fort Pulaski, Georgia to Confederates
- Apr 16 Slavery abolished in the District of Columbia
- Apr 18 Bombardment begins at Ft. Jackson and Ft. St. Philip, 70 miles below New Orleans, LA
- Apr 24 Federal fleet passes forts below New Orleans, Louisiana
- Apr 25 Bombardment and surrender of Fort Macon, North Carolina
- Apr 29 Union "army group" advances on Corinth, Mississippi
